- PTA President's Report Two successful meet and greets this summer. 100 ppl last night. 37 people signed up in MemberHub. Signup Genius for staff breakfast to be held Tuesday, 8/22 drop off and set up starting at 7 a.m. New student orientation on the 24th, then a block party for all students. Block party from 2:30-4:30. Already reserved blacktop, bathrooms, all the areas that we need. Mr. Smart has Pit Beef truck attending that day. Will be at PVMS from 11 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. PTA will supply popsicles, juice, cookies, and chips. Would like feedback on games. Human ring toss. Cup stacking. A few years ago, parents brought in yard games, can you let them know. Gaga pit, basketball. Also, PE equipment. Will need some help with setting up for the block party. (not 6th grade parents b/c they will be busy) All the goodies will be pre-packaged.
- Principal's Report Mr. Smart Bulldog strong. Putting the first things first: Relationships, learning, and structure. There's a real sense that there is community here; all still emerging from the pandemic. Hoping to get some real partnership between parents and staff Hoping staff members will sign up. What Mr. Smart hopes from this conversation is that we don't hide info. He'd like to discuss solutions. PVMS is not yet known about he wants to put us on the map! Hopes he can stay 5 years or more.

Did break them down into categories etc. 8th grade activities there was a large donation last year to the school. \$7,000 activities. Mr. Smart knows about this and he can see what was spent on 8th grade activities from the PVMS, vs. what the PTA spent on 8th grade activities. e.g., school dance how much does it cost?
