# **Meeting Minutes**

## ❖ Introductions/Welcome

- > Approximately 17 parents/guardians were in attendance + parents on Zoom
- ❖ Meeting Minutes Motion to approve the November 2023 Meeting Minutes accepted and seconded. Meeting Minutes approved. (Note: No December meeting = no minutes.)
- ❖ PTA President's Report Hala discussed the idea of our PTA changing to be a PTSA (Parent Teacher Student Association). Hala has been doing research on this topic. The Student Council is interested in participating and leading with us. She is confident that our kids have the skills to be able to do that. A change to PTSA can be done by modifying the by-laws. Hala would like to try to implement for the next school year. Only 5 middle schools in Howard County are PTSAs; the rest are PTAs.

- ➤ Please let Mr. Smart know if we'd like to hear about specific topics.
- Recently looked at a "state of the school" for the staff as we approach the middle of the school year. More interventions than in previous years at this time, but those are alternatives to suspensions. He had to send out an email about social

media last week. Change of leadership in the school system. Dr. Martirano retired; Mr. William Barnes began his service as Acting Superintendent on January 10. Mr. Smart knows of Mr. Barnes from other roles in the county. Budget will be a topic.

- ➤ Celebrations for honor roll families invited. Families will be invited again next quarter. "Honor Roll" and "On a Roll."
- > Q: Times for the concerts can they be included in the principal's report? A: Yes!
- ❖ Guest Speakers Presentation from 6<sup>th</sup> Grade School Counselor, Ms. Jamie Kim
  - Since 2018, there has been a 400% increase in vaping. Companies are targeting middle school and high school students to get their money. While they are underage and can't purchase, they find ways. Very accessible. Vaping: more prevalent especially in high schools. Not as prevalent in middle school. But have seen devices at PVMS.
