- ❖ **PTACHC Delegate Report**
 - After-prom update given at the PTACHC meeting. Proms were held in the county during the April 28 through May 26 timeframe. Talked about student attendance and how all the events went (proms and after-proms). Also at the meeting, talked about the River Hill HS incident (the false bomb threat and lockdown), which also hit other schools earlier this year. Parents said they were receiving information from their students instead of from the school system. They are surveying parents and will package information on what parents would like to see, and will share with everyone next school year.
